Telehealth involves the use of technologies such as telephone-based services, videoconferencing, texting, smartphone applications and web-based tools to provide care over a distance without requiring individuals or families to travel to a clinic or provider's office.



Benefits

Accessibility

Mass population access to services that would otherwise not be available to them.

Passionate and Committed

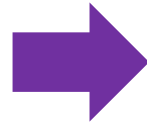
- We will build a team of passionate people who are dedicated to helping others.

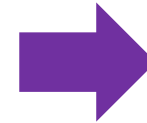
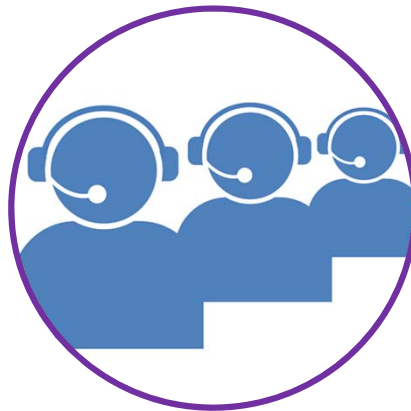


Member Engagement Workflow

Members download app and pay for a chosen Recovery package or access through their Group/Employers subscription benefit plan.



ON DEMAND
Members receive care/support via chat, call, or video conference through the mobile app.



Members/RCP's schedule follow-ups and complete feedback.



Members can choose on-demand support or schedule an appointment with a Recovery Coach Professional or other providers.

SCHEDULED
Members complete their own wellness plans for care and tracking outcomes.

Members have access to other resources and self-help toolkits available through the app.


Why Recovery Coach Professionals



- CCAR Recovery Coach Professionals are trained individuals with varied lived experiences been vetted by the Center for Addiction Recovery, a program of Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery
- Recovery Coach Professionals view recovery as something that is naturally attractive and occurs when the person or family is in touch with the outcomes they want in their life and has ongoing support, capital and accountability in their capacity to be successful.
- Completed 60 Hours of CCAR Approved Training and experience with the addiction recovery process.
- Understanding of medication-assisted recovery and practices.
- Capability of building an effective relationship and navigating resources.
- Demonstrated skill in actively listening, asking good questions, awareness of self and treating people as resources.
- Cross-cultural skills, and experience with culturally diverse populations.


How to Become a CCAR Recovery Coach Professional

1. Applicants must complete 60 CEUs of training. CCAR Recovery Coach Academy and CCAR Ethical Considerations for Recovery Coaches training are required. Additional credits can be obtained from other CCAR trainings or from another training provider with focus on addiction and recovery.
2. Submit a completed application with copies of all certificates, a resume and/or an essay sharing your experience of addiction recovery or interest in recovery coaching.
3. Mail application packet and a check for \$149 to CCAR at 75 Charter Oak Avenue, Suite 1-305, Hartford, Connecticut 06106.
4. If eligible, applicants will be scheduled a phone interview with a panel of CCAR staff and recovery coaches.

What's Next?

Telehealth Recovery Network has partnered with the Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery to recruit individuals with the Recovery Coach Professional Designation to join our team as a contracted/hired part time and full-time service. We are looking for 100 RCP's to join by Q2 2020.

Like Uber or Lyft, contracted RCPs will have the ability to establish their own hours as calls will be coming in from all around the country. RCPs will also be able to market themselves as TRN Coaches for promotional and business opportunities. You will be able to add your own bio and picture as well.

TRN Coaches will be given access to several perks including marketing opportunities, additional training, platform recognition bonuses and more.

The TRN RCP position provides telephonic/video problem solving, action plan development, and recommendations and referrals to appropriate resources within the scope of alcohol and drug, mental health and other family, health, and social services. The app will utilize the CCAR wellness plan template as well a frequent quality of life check in.

Base amounts per session/hour will be established. We are waiting on feedback from RCPs, investors and partners.
